Virtual PBX provides a solution for this problem with its award-winning PBX Parachute Service. PBX Parachute is a hot-standby phone service that can automatically and instantly take over if your premise-based phone system goes down. Calls can then be routed to pre-determined alternate locations, such as branch offices, cellular phones or home phones. Callers still reach the people they need and business can continue as usual.

Down or Inaccessible, Remote Works Best


Phone systems can be made inaccessible in a wide variety of ways. Power failures, component breakdowns,, or simple cable breaks can cause the phone system itself to fail. These could be the result of natural disasters or human error. Sometimes, having a secondary system on site can help you recover from this type of problem, though the cost can be very high. PBX Parachute is an inexpensive standby service that is shared by many other users, so the cost to you is far less than a duplicate PBX switch.

And what if a storm, earthquake, or even a police action simply makes your place of business inaccessible? During major storms whole cities may be shut down and while your standby PBX might be working, you can't get into the building to activate it, and employees can't get to their desks to take calls. PBX Parachute is located remotely, away from your office. Something that affects your building or city will not impact our equipment in its location.

Automatic Failover or Managed Use

In the event of a phone system failure, incoming calls can be automatically or manually redirected to PBX Parachute. Each PBX Parachute system has its own local or toll-free number, and multiple numbers if you need them. Toll-free numbers offer Direct Termination Overflow, which can automatically reroute calls to an alternate phone number if the primary number doesn't answer, and many local number services offer the same kind of service.

Alternatively, you can set things up with your phone company such that a single call will redirect traffic to PBX Parachute. Calls are routed to alternate phones just as with the automatic implementation, it just puts you in total control of when to invoke PBX Parachute. You can also use this approach to test the system at any time.
